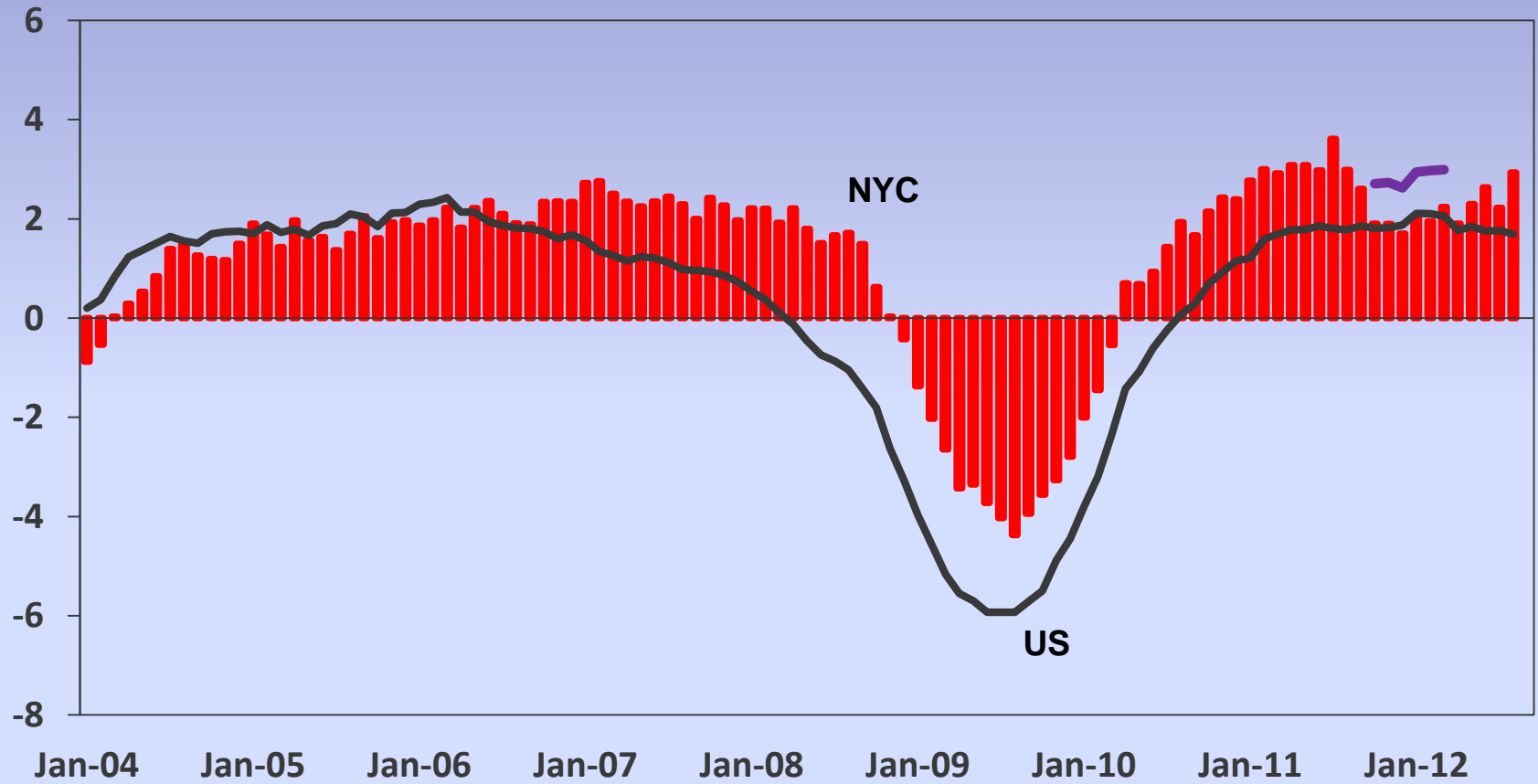

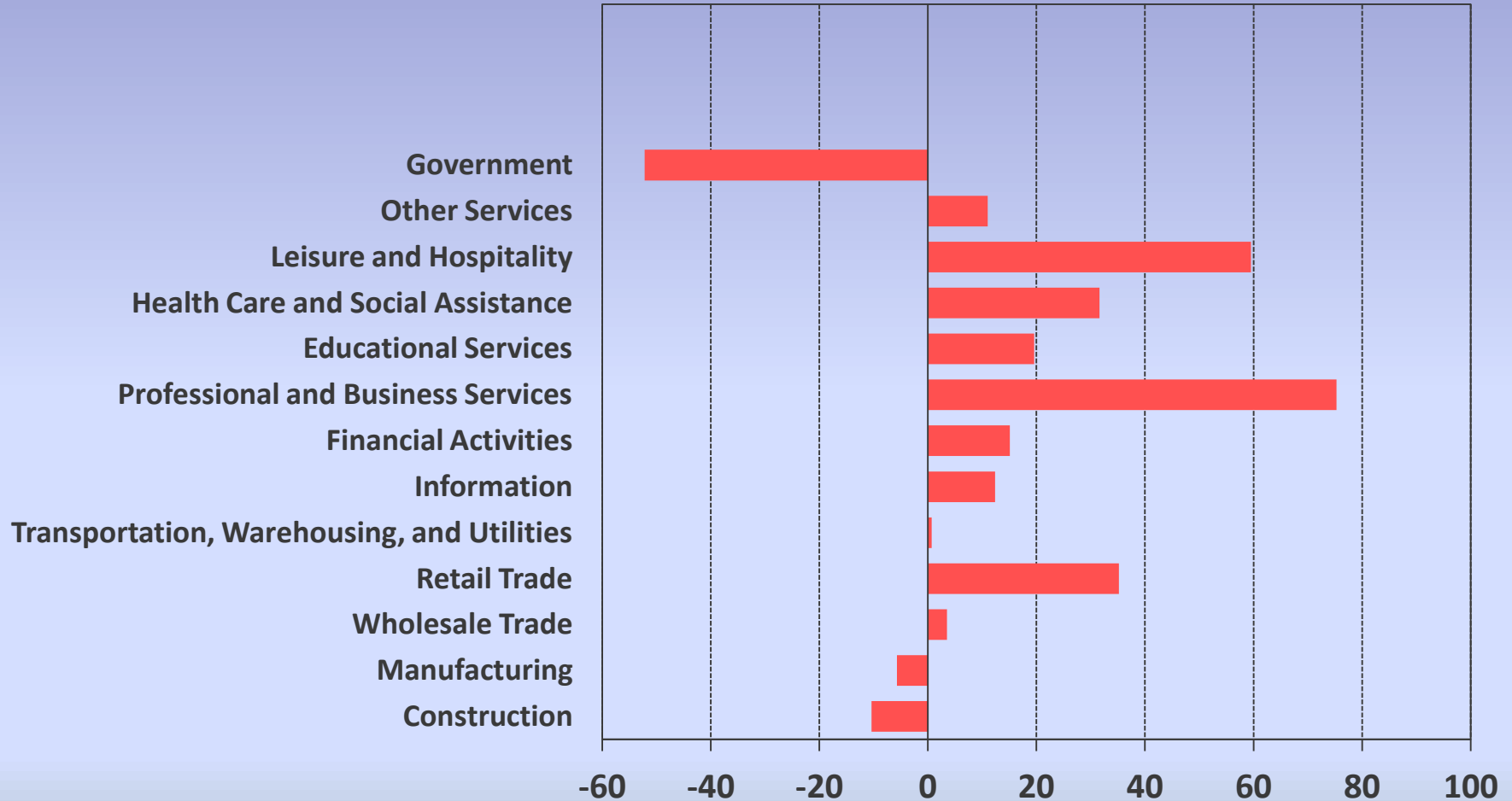

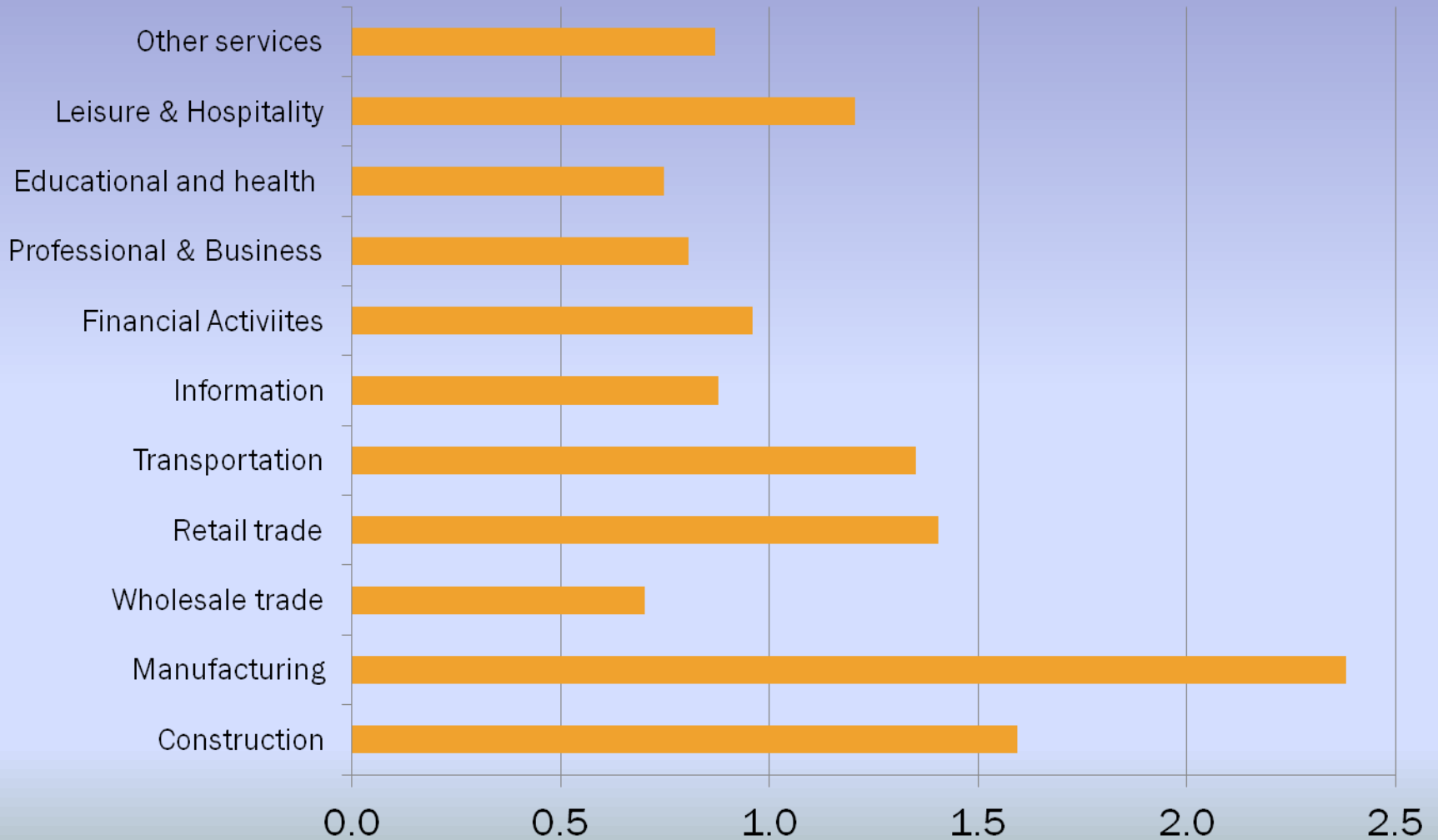
12-MONTH PERCENT CHANGE

% NYC EMPLOYED RESIDENTS/% NYC PRIVATE SECTOR JOBS

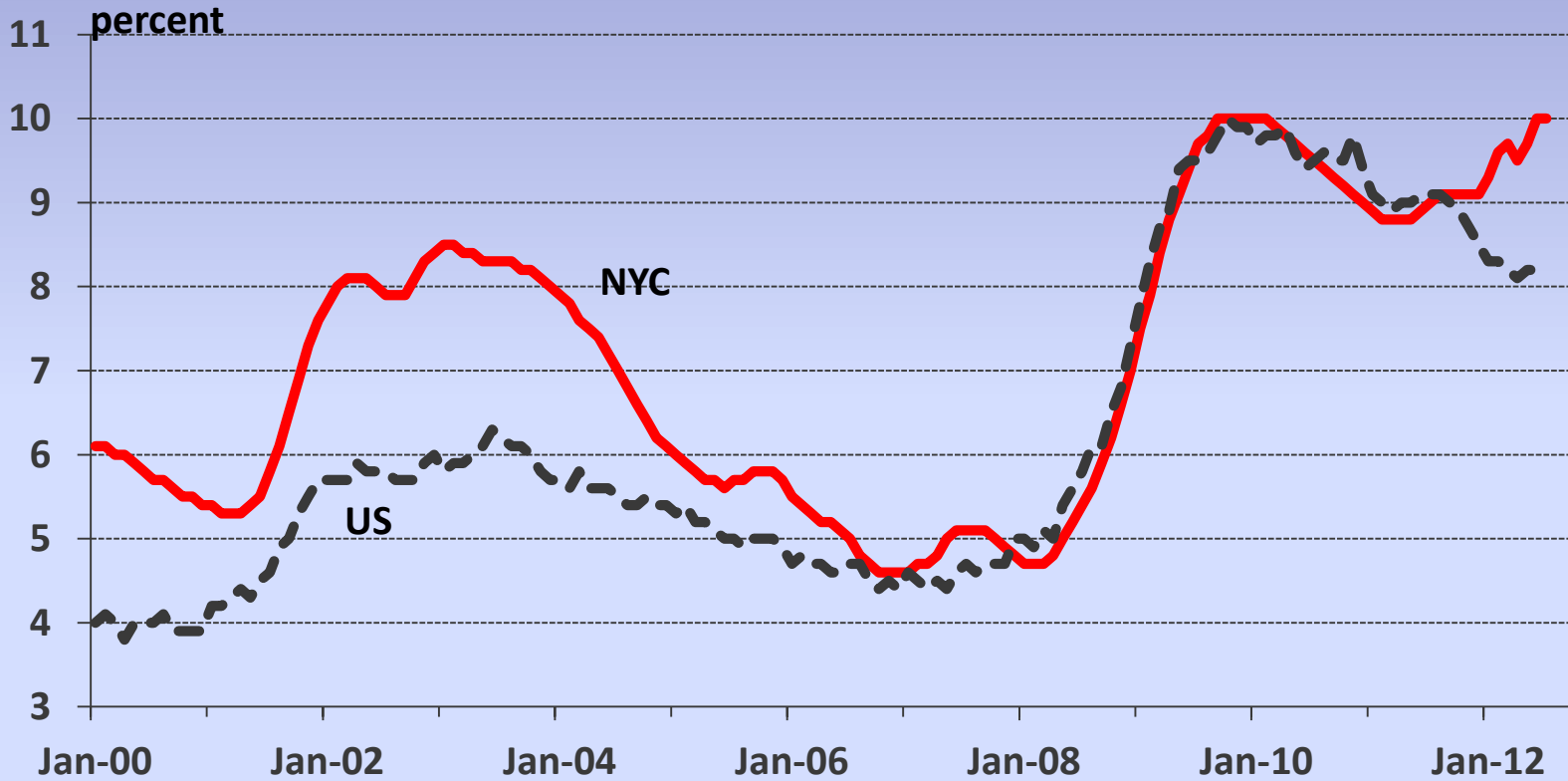

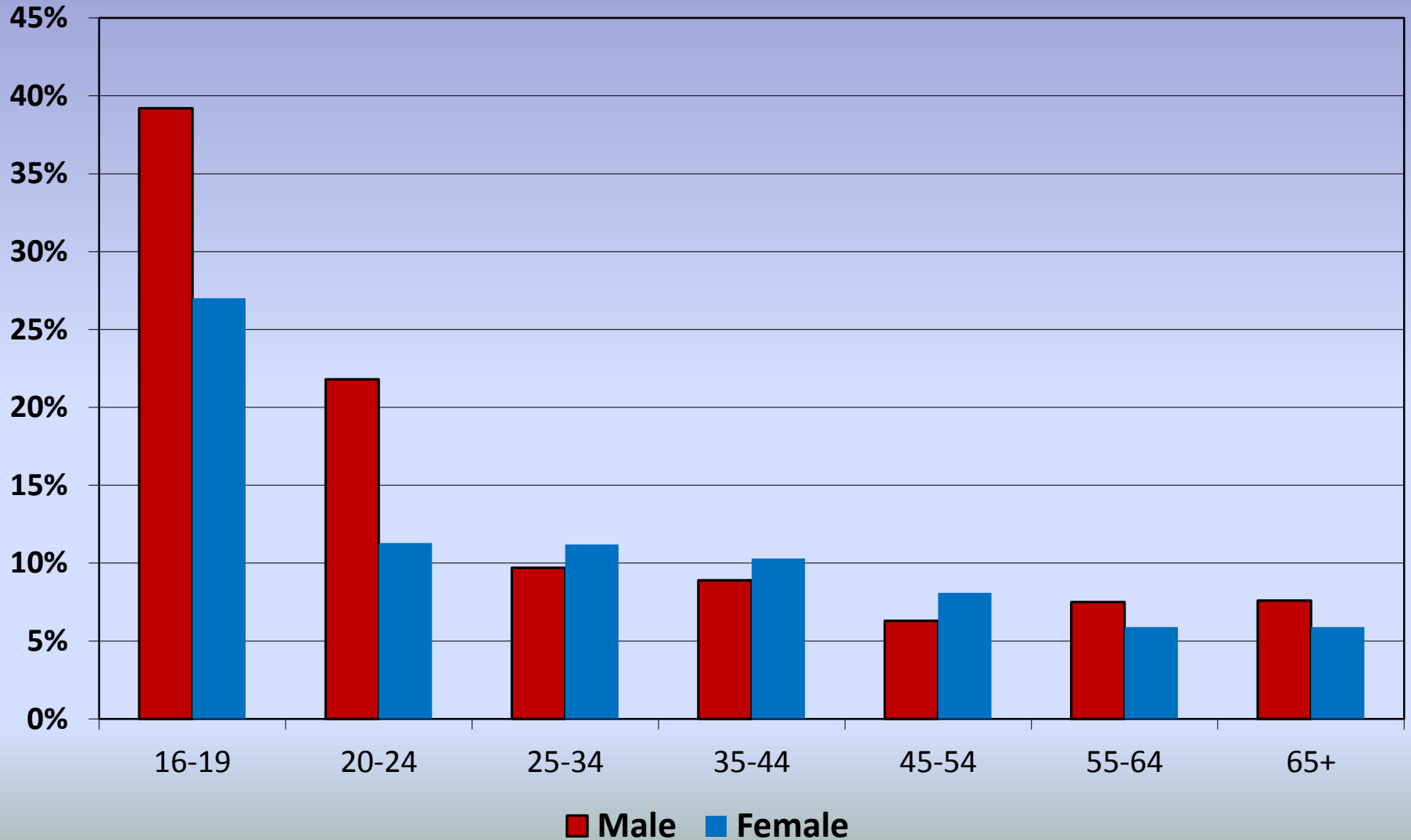

YEAR-ENDING August 2012



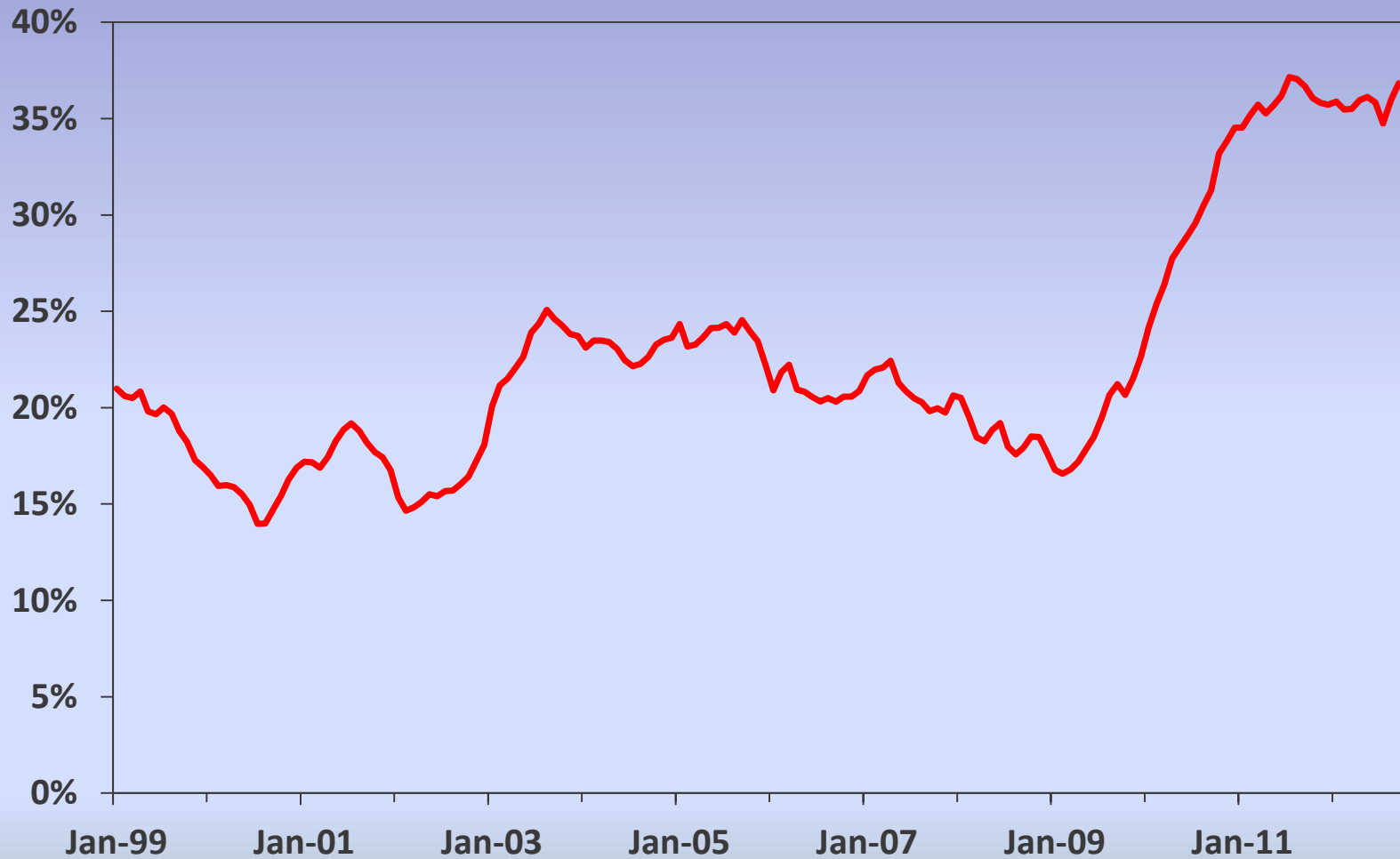
NEW YORK CITY PART-TIME FOR ECONOMIC REASONS

SHARE OF WORKFORCE, 12-MONTH AVERAGE, %

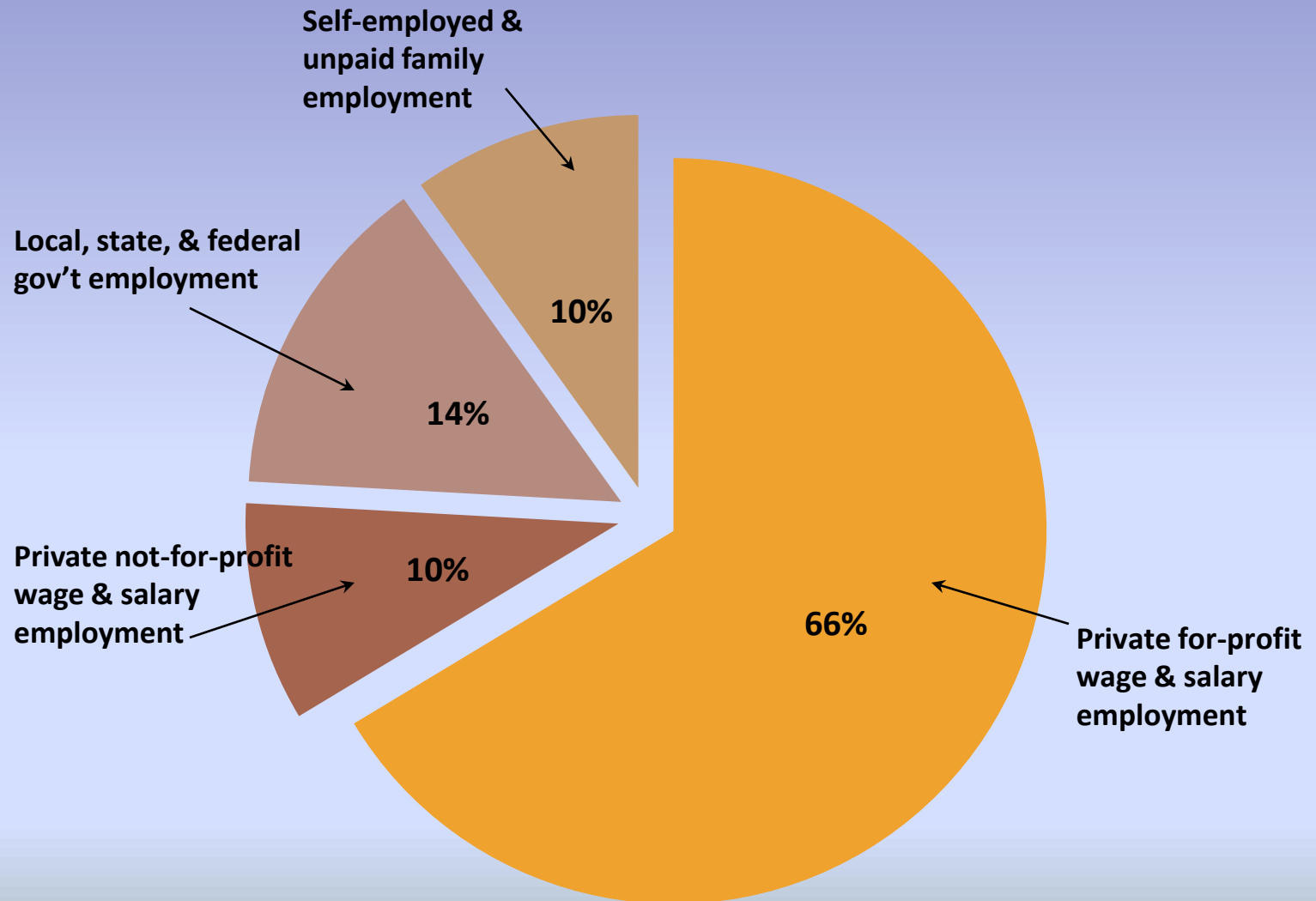


NEW YORK CITY UNEMPLOYED 52 WEEKS+

NEW YORK CITY LABOR FORCE BY TYPE OF EMPLOYMENT, 2008-2010

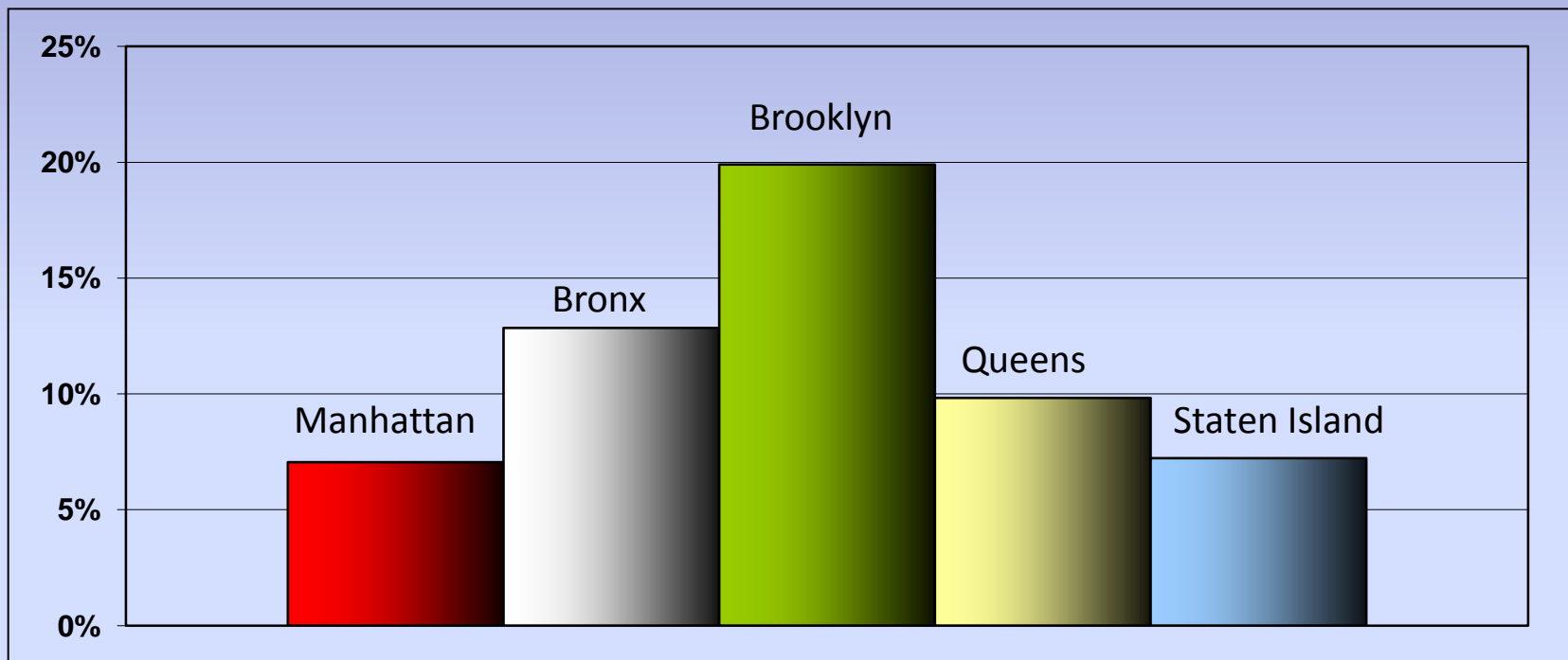
